

### **If you are using Google Chrome™**

You need to disable the Chrome PDF viewer and enable the Adobe Acrobat PDF viewer.

- 1 - Open a new tab and type the address : 'chrome://plugins/'.
- 2 - Click the Enable link in 'Adobe Reader' field.
- 3 - Click the Disable link in 'Chrome PDF Viewer field'.
- 4 - Close the tab.
- 5 - Close and reopen your browser.

### **If you are using Internet Explorer™**

We recommend using Internet Explorer v9 or higher.

To consult or print document, we recommend the installation of the latest version of Adobe Acrobat Reader.

### **If you are using Mozilla Firefox™**

You need to disable the Adobe Acrobat plug-in for Mozilla Firefox.

Below procedure is based on Firefox 24. Depending on the version of Firefox you are using, the procedure can be slightly different.

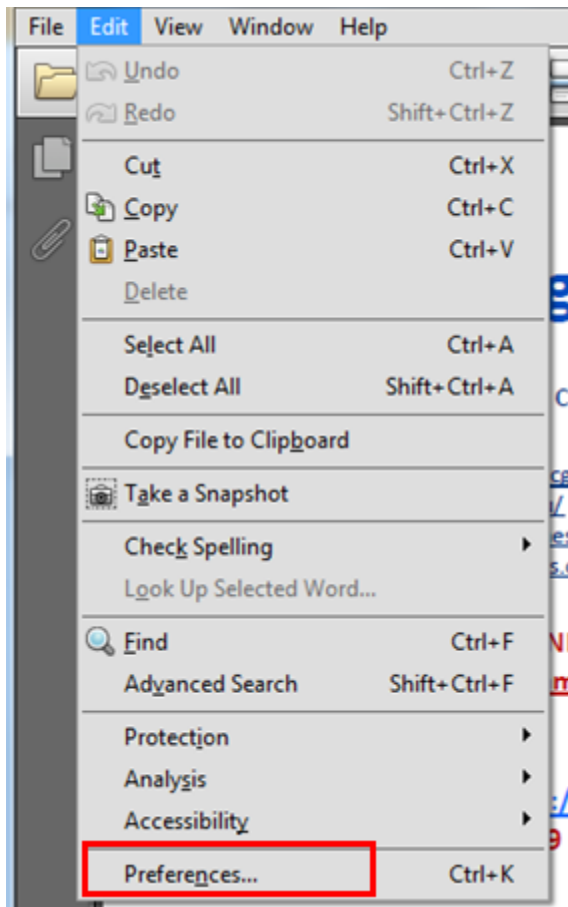
- 1 - Open Mozilla Firefox. Click on the 'Firefox' menu in the top left corner.
- 2 - Click on 'Add Ons' menu and then on 'Plugin' tab.
- 3 - Choose 'Never Activate' in the menu corresponding to the 'Adobe Acrobat' plugin..
- 4 - Open 'Firefox' menu on the top left menu bar and choose menu 'Option'.
- 5 - In the 'Applications' Tab, choose « Always Ask » action for Portable Document Format (PDF) Content Type.
- 6 - Close and reopen your browser.
