## IMPORT PROCEDURE FOR OUTPORT SHIPMENT

- 1. Consignee must provide supporting document for BC 1.2 (transshipment clearance process) two Days prior vessel ETA JKT/SUB at the latest, consist of:
  - Invoice and packing list, HS code, DG DECLARATION (if commodity classified as DG)
  - Legality document such as API, NIK and NPWP (only need to provide once)
  - Statement letter that mention goods receiver address at final POD if BL not mention actual goods receiver address at FPOD
  - For shipment that adjustment manifest / submit flatfile to provide copy HBL
- 2. CMA-CGM will compile all documents for BC 1.2 (transshipment clearance process) to customs Jakarta/Surabaya (approximately takes 5-7 working days)
- 3. Once cargo confirm loaded from Jakarta/Surabaya, CMA-CGM / sub agents will inform the sailing schedule to consignee
- 4. CMA-CGM sub agents at FPOD will sent NOA and invoice local charge to consignee
- <u>5.</u> CMA-CGM sub agents will send D/O release request to CMA-CGM for releasing cargo at terminal purpose

## Special note:

- For cargo destination to Perawang, there are two terminal: IKPP terminal (especially for APP Group shipment only) and Pelindo terminal (owned by government for general/public shipment)
- For cargo to Padang, HS code is mandatory to declare on manifest
