



Strike announcement July 2023 Action Plan

Dear Valued Customer

Following this week's escalation in the dispute between the Swedish dockworkers' union and the Swedish port authority, we hereby inform you of the upcoming strike notice made for application between July 6th to July 11th in Helsingborg.

This will regretfully effect some of our service(s) calling Sweden between these dates. Below you can find our action plan for the concerned sailings.

As the dispute is ongoing and can change drastically, we reserve the right to change the below setup on short notice.

We are doing everything we can do to find best alternative solutions for your cargo at the lowest cost but are obliged to inform you that all extra costs incurred by the strike such as waiting times, extra handling, re-routings, port storage, detention and demurrage etc. is for the account of the cargo owner.

If the situation further deteriorates, we reserve the right to implement other charges to cover our extra cost.

Helsingborg week 27

Since the port is targeted for strike, our departure (0C702S1MA) on Thursday July 6th will be suspended.

Import

All containers planned to arrive on 0C702S1MA will be rescheduled to arrive on the next CMA CGM Helsingborg call in week 28 instead.

Export

All export containers booked for departure on CMA CGM voy 0C702S1MA will be rolled to next CMA CGM Helsingborg sailing in week 28. Please note that container pick-up dates and delivery times will be updated accordingly.

Containers delivered to the terminal on previous delivery times will be subject to storage and D/D charges as per contract.

All other CMA CGM services in Gävle, Norrköping, Stockholm, Göteborg and Halmstad are scheduled to run as normal.

At CMA CGM we are closely monitoring the development in Swedish ports and are preparing alternatives to avoid further delays and minimize the impact on you as our customer.
